**Travel Lane Transition Reconfiguration from between Beverly Glen
and Overland Ave. October 7 – October 9, 2005**

What work will be done?	The contractor will commence staging for the reconstruction of the North side of Santa Monica Blvd between Overland Ave. and Beverly Glen. The existing travel lanes will be relocated southerly. The northern half of the roadway will become work area. Re-striping, traffic signal relocation, and transition of traffic will take place throughout the weekend.
Where is the work occurring?	The North side of the Santa Monica Blvd. between Beverly Glen and Overland Ave. One travel lane, in each direction, will be available during the transition period. New travel lanes will open for traffic on Saturday evening. On-street parking is prohibited along the work zone during this weekend.
When will work begin and end?	Work will begin on Friday, October 7, 2005 and will continue through Sunday, October 9, 2005.
What time will crews be working?	Crews will work continuously between 9pm on Friday, October 7, 2005 to Sunday, October 9 at 6pm.
What can I expect?	Drivers can expect congestion during the transition period. Please be aware that the new traffic pattern will be in place for the duration of this construction phase - expected to be complete in the Spring of 2006. Look for future notices on continued work in this area.
Will local access be permitted?	Local access is permitted. Los Angeles Traffic Officers will be available at all signalized intersections during the relocation of signal lights.
